POLICIES INCLUDING EBR

EXPERIENCE BASED REFUND (EBR)

If the Plan selected on your Mechanical Breakdown Insurance Policy includes EBR (Experienced Based Refund), you can apply for a refund as soon as the Policy has expired by time. Refunds are based on the amount you originally paid for the Policy, up to a maximum claim amount of \$1,500.

Criteria for the EBR claim include:

- Original Policyholder must still be registered owner of watercraft.
- No mechanical or any other benefit claims were made during the entire term.
- EBR claim must be requested and received in the allotted time frame.

OPTIONAL GPR COVERAGE

GUARANTEED PRICE REBATE (GPR)

(Available on qualifying Mechanical Breakdown Contracts) If you selected and paid the GPR Fee on an eligible plan, you can apply for a rebate claim as soon as the Contract term has expired by time. Rebates are based on the amount you originally paid for the Contract, up to a maximum claim amount of \$1,500. Criteria for the GPR claim include:

- Original Contract holder must still be registered owner of watercraft.
- No mechanical or any other benefit claims were made during the entire term.
- GPR claim must be requested and received in the allotted time frame.

Additional Benefits Included in **All Levels of Coverage** (when applicable)

TOWING



In the event of a Breakdown, We will pay or reimburse You for receipted towing expenses up to one hundred dollars (\$100). Any payment shall be for actual towing expense charges in excess of any applicable reimbursement from the manufacturer or any other towing service coverage.

TRIP INTERRUPTION

In the event of a Breakdown which occurs more than one hundred and sixty (160) kilometres from your home and results in a repair facility keeping Your Watercraft overnight, We will pay or reimburse You for receipted lodging and meal expenses up to one hundred dollars (\$100) per day up to a maximum of three hundred dollars (\$300) per Breakdown event. In order to qualify for Trip Interruption, Your Watercraft must be equipped with a minimum of one berth.



LIFT/HAUL OUT

In the event of a Breakdown, We will pay or reimburse You for all receipted expenses up to one hundred dollars (\$100) per occurrence to remove Your Watercraft from the water to perform necessary repairs. This benefit applies only when it is necessary to remove Your Watercraft from the water to complete a covered repair.
